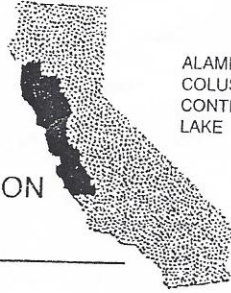

Dear Mr Tran,

Records at this office were reviewed to determine if this project could adversely affect cultural resources. **Please note that use of the term cultural resources includes both archaeological sites and historical buildings and/or structures. The review for possible historic-era building/structures, however, was limited to references currently in our office and should not be considered comprehensive.**

**Previous Studies:**

XX Study # 36071 (Clark, 2009), covering approximately 100% of the proposed project area, was a Cultural Resources Inventory of the Castro Valley Sanitary District (*see recommendation below*).

**Archaeological and Native American Resources Recommendations:**

XX The proposed project area has the possibility of containing unrecorded archaeological site(s). Because the previous study was more of an overview with field inspection only at locations of planned ground disturbance, a new study is recommended prior to commencement of project activities.

XX We recommend you contact the local Native American tribe(s) regarding traditional, cultural, and religious heritage values. For a complete listing of tribes in the vicinity of the project, please contact the Native American Heritage Commission at 916/653-4082.

**Built Environment Recommendations:**

XX Since the Office of Historic Preservation has determined that any building or structure 45 years or older may be of historical value, if the project area contains such properties, it is recommended that prior to commencement of project activities, a qualified professional familiar with the architecture and history of Alameda County conduct a formal CEQA evaluation.

If archaeological resources are encountered during the project, work in the immediate vicinity of the finds should be halted until a qualified archaeologist has evaluated the situation.
