Delete Paragraph 2 found in Section I of County Provisions:

Small and Emerging Locally Owned Business: A small business for purposes of this RFQ is defined by the United States Small Business Administration and must be certified by the County for the following NAICS Code(s): 561730 as having no more than \$7,000,000 in average annual gross receipts over the last three (3) years. An emerging business, as defined by the County, is one that has less than one-half (1/2) of the preceding amount and has been in business less than five (5) years. In order to participate herein, the small or emerging business must also satisfy the locality requirements and be certified by the County as a Small or Emerging, local business

And replace with the following paragraph:

Small and Emerging Locally Owned Business: A small business for purposes of this RFQ is defined by the United States Small Business Administration and must be certified by the County for the following NAICS Code(s): **238210** and 561730 as having no more than \$7,000,000 in average annual gross receipts over the last three (3) years. An emerging business, as defined by the County, is one that has less than one-half (1/2) of the preceding amount and has been in business less than five (5) years. In order to participate herein, the small or emerging business must also satisfy the locality requirements and be certified by the County as a Small or Emerging, local business
