HIGH STREET & PARK STREET BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

High Street Bridge and Park Street Bridge are two of four estuary bridges in Alameda County that provide access to the City of Alameda. A recent engineering study conducted for both bridges recommended repairing the two bridge decks for improved traction and safety, replacement of the vehicle barrier on the Park Street Bridge and replacement of the bridge deck center lock on the High Street Bridge.

The Alameda County Public Works Agency will work with the cities, surrounding business associations, Coast Guard, mariners, and other bridge users to minimize inconveniences during construction and to expedite the schedule whenever possible.

GETTING AROUND DURING CONSTRUCTION

Park Street Bridge

- Deck repair work will take place during nighttime. Bridge will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- Bridge will be on single-leaf operation for marine traffic passage.

High Street Bridge

- Deck repairs and center lock replacement require closure to vehicular traffic.
- Construction during the center lock replacement will require the bridge to be closed to marine traffic for safety reasons.

Traffic control measures will be implemented. Information will be available at the Public Works Agency website. Refer to the U.S. Coast Guard's Notice to Mariners for marine closure information.
