Subject: Update on Upcoming Construction Activities Along Sulphur Creek between Union Pacific Railroad and Vicinity of Cabot Boulevard

The purpose of this notice is to provide an update on the upcoming levee and channel remedial construction work that the Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will be performing this spring/summer along Sulphur Creek (Zone 2 Line K) between the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) and pump station located west of Cabot Blvd.

The following construction information is provided for reference:

Anticipated Construction Schedule

❖ Start date: May 7, 2012

❖ Duration: May thru end of September 2012

- ❖ Construction hours: 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Mondays thru Fridays. No work on weekends
- ❖ Truck haul route: along Cabot Blvd (north of W. Winton Avenue) and Corsair Boulevard to Stearman Avenue. Truck hauling will take place between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM, with occasional hauling after 3:00 PM.

During Construction Hours

- ❖ No parking will be allowed for approximately 60 feet from the flood control access gate on Cabot Boulevard and temporary construction entrance gate on Stearman Avenue, to provide adequate truck turning area.
- Various size of construction equipment will be used to construct the necessary improvements within the District right-of-way.
- During work hours, all driveway access should be maintained.

After Construction Hours

- ❖ Construction equipment will be parked or staged in designated areas on District property.
- ❖ Parking restrictions along curb side will not apply after 5:30 PM.

While the District continually strives to minimize construction impact to adjacent property owners/tenants, we also recognize the likelihood of increased noise levels during construction operations due to construction machinery and activities.
