Subject: Flood Control Improvements along Zone 5, Line M at Alameda Creek

This letter is to inform you that the Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will be constructing improvements at the Line M channel outfall structure to enhance flood protection by widening the existing outfall structure to increase flow conveyance to Alameda Creek. The following construction information is provided for reference:

Anticipated Construction Schedule

- ❖ Anticipated Start Date: May 7, 2012
- ❖ Construction Duration: May thru November 2012.
- ❖ Construction Hours: 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM, Mondays thru Fridays. No work on weekends.
- ❖ Truck Hauling Route (Mondays thru Fridays): along Perry Road and Decoto Road:
 - May to June 15, and August 20 to end of construction: 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM
 - June 18 to August 17: 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM

What to Expect During Construction

- ❖ Construction access will be at the end of Perry Road. Construction equipment will be parked or staged in the designated area in the District right-of-way or in the City vacant lot at end of Perry Road.
- ❖ The trail on Alameda Creek north levee and along Line M to Royal Ann Drive will remain open; continuity of pedestrian passage will be maintained via a short detour on a temporary pedestrian bridge over Line M. Intermittent short duration closure may be necessary to allow construction equipment to pass through.
- ❖ Various sizes of construction equipment will be used to construct the necessary improvements within the District right-of-way.

While the District continually strives to minimize construction impact to adjacent residents, we also recognize the likelihood of increased noise levels during construction operations due to construction machinery and activities.
